Road Safety Tips



Stand Back

30cm away from wing mirrors



STOP

At a safe place where you can see the traffic



LOOK

For moving traffic



LISTEN

For traffic noise, wait if you do



THINK!

Is it safe to cross



Be Bright Be Seen

Wear **bright** or **fluorescent** clothes during the **day**, particularly in dull or misty weather (remember that fluorescent clothing doesn't really work after dark)

Use **reflective** materials at **night** as these will show up in the car headlights. Reflective strips can be put on clothing, bags, shoes and other equipment

Only cycle at night if you have a working white front light, red back light and a red reflector.

Bus Safety Tips

- Walk when near a bus
- Running in front or behind the bus is dangerous, because the driver might not see you when they drive off
- Crossing near a bus is dangerous, because there might be traffic passing that you can not see
- Find a safer place to cross if you can
- Always use Stand back, Stop, Look, Listen and Think
