

THE IMPACT OF HOW WE SPEND OUR PUPIL PREMIUM FUNDING AT HIPSURN PRIMARY SCHOOL
(DATA)

In 2016/17, 0 % of our Early Years pupils were in receipt of Pupil Premium

In 2016/17, 60% of our Year 1 pupils in receipt of Pupil Premium (5/20 of cohort) achieved the expected standard in the Phonics Screening Check compared to 70% nationally (2016) and 92% for other pupils not in receipt of Pupil Premium.
