### Pupil Reading Survey

At Hipsburn Primary School, we value our pupils' opinions. 25% of our pupils, from preschool up to year 6, were chosen randomly to complete this survey about reading.

| I enjoy reading                            | 46.4%          | 50%   | 96.4%                         |          | 3.6%              |

| My teacher reads to me                     | 46.4%          | 42.9% | 89.3%                         | 10.7%    |                   |
| My classroom has a good reading/ book area | 35.7%          | 50%   | 85.7%                         | 14.3%    |                   |
| I use the school library                   | 32.1%          | 50%   | 82.1%                         | 7.2%     | 10.7%             |
