- Create a fact file about Paddington Bear.
- Read & write instructions: How to make a marmalade sandwich.
- Drama: act out a Paddington adventure.
- Recounts - write a postcard to Aunt Lucy.
- Non-fiction report writing - Things to see and do in London.

Art

- Design a new duffle coat for Paddington.
- Create a collage of deepest darkest Peru using mixed media.
- Look at the work of Edward Wilson discuss colours and techniques.
- Recreate a piece of Edward Wilson's work (penguin) using pastels.

Music

- BBC Ten pieces - body percussion.
- Exploring Pitch
- Create a piece of music using body percussion to match the bath scene from the Paddington film.

History
