# School Council

- Meet twice every half term
- Look at things in school that you would like to change
- Discuss ideas and how you will make them happen

School Council members will have the chance to ask all the children in their class their opinions about what is to be discussed at the next meeting.

# What will the School Council do?

- Identify what your class thinks about issues and give feedback at meetings.
- Improve parts of the school that are a priority, like the forest area.
- Help organise events and fundraise.
- Decide on action points for improvements.
