# Walk to school week - Monday 6th October to Friday 10th October

Next week is **Walk to School Week!** Where possible, we encourage families to walk to school, or even park a little further away to enjoy a walk to school. Walking to school helps children work towards their recommended 60 minutes of daily activity, while also helping the environment. Teachers will check in throughout the week and children who have managed to walk to school every day will let their teachers know on Friday the 10th and receive a sticker/bookmark. Children in KS1 and 2 will receive an optional activity booklet during the week as well. We will also be holding an assembly and raising awareness within our classes of the benefits of walking to school.

# School Meals

All children in Reception, Y1, and Y2 are eligible for universal free school meals, regardless of household income. However, if you feel you may be eligible for Free School Meals (FSM) it is important that you apply immediately as families eligible for free school meals through Pupil Premium funding can apply for support, which not only provides a free meal each day, free breakfast club and discounted trips but also helps the school access additional funding to enhance learning experiences. Currently the LA also provides FSM families with vouchers to cover the cost of clothing and food during the school holidays. Please consider an eligibility













check for FSM when applying to a School and do not wait until your child is in year 3. If you think your child may be entitled to free school meals (FSM), please apply via this link: <u>Application for free school meals</u>.

Universal Free School Meals (UIFSM): All children in Reception, Year 1, and Year 2 are eligible for universal free school meals, regardless of household income.
