To support our Personal, Social and Emotional development, we will be thinking about feelings and relationships. Children will develop their ability to deal with feelings in a positive way, learning to play with others co-operatively.

This half term our topic our weekly themes are as follows:

Learning is tailored to the children's individual interests, therefore we do sometimes divert from our themed topic to accommodate this. The children lead their own learning and the teachers engage with them to support and extend this, ensuring learning is meaningful and relevant to each child.

Please ensure your child has spare clothes, nappies/wipes/nappy sacks, appropriate outdoor clothing and labelled wellies for our forest as we will continue to get outside whatever the weather. It would also be helpful if you could let us know in the mornings if your child is having a school dinner or their own packed lunch as the children aren't always sure when asked at register time.

For our new parents your child will be given a key-person who will work closely alongside them to support their wellbeing and development. Please feel free to arrange a time to speak to your key-person about any concerns or particular interests your child may have. Parents are a child's first teacher, you have already played an important part in your child's learning and development and we really do appreciate anything you could share with us. We are so excited to observe any changes and explore the natural environment in our forest. It is a wonderful time of year for us all to feel a connection and appreciation for nature.
